ABOUT THE CHILDREN

BCC VISION

The Barrington Children's Choir (BCC) seeks to ignite the power and joy of song within children's lives, inspiring them to be lifelong lovers and learners of music, while bringing together communities throughout the Chicago Northwest Suburbs and beyond .

Established in 1986, BCC has long been devoted to uniting the purity and simplicity of children's voices with the finest traditional and contemporary choral music. Today, more than 30 years later — and building on the cherished mission of founding artistic director Peggy Crawford — BCC continues to offer the finest concepts in music learning, creating best-in-class choral teams that inspire others through the power of artistic training and performance.

BCC choristers span grades 2 through 12 and represent the Chicago Northwest Suburbs and beyond. The children are taught diverse and extensive American and multicultural repertoire including folk, classical, renaissance and contemporary music in native languages.

PLACEMENT PROCESS

Admission to the choir – with the exception of our youngest group of singers -- is by placement and evaluation, and the children selected must be willing to commit time for weekly rehearsals and three to five performances each season. Based upon age and experience, the children are placed in one of the following choirs:

GRACE NOTES

Typically grades two through four. Singers of all musical ability levels are accepted and instruction will focus on good quality vocal production, unison and simple part singing, and overall musicianship training including ROTE learning and an introduction to solfege and basic music reading skills.

PRELUDE

Typically grades four through six. The pedagogy of this ensemble will focus intensely on music reading and vocal performance, through the rehearsal and performance of more challenging choral repertoire. Singers will be singing in 2 and 3 vocal parts and advance their aural skills through a continuation of ROTE learning as well as a more rigorous use of solfege.



CHAMBER CHOIR

Our primary performance ensemble, singers accepted into Chamber Choir demonstrate a passion and dedication for the performance of choral music. The pedagogy of this ensemble will focus on professional-level choral rehearsal techniques combining ROTE learning, solfege singing, and music reading for the purpose of learning, memorizing and performing advanced choral repertoire.

ACAPPELLA

This select ensemble comprises singers who are also enrolled in Chamber Choir. Members of this advanced group will exclusively sing contemporary and traditional acapella repertoire.





THE PERFORMANCES

In addition to BCC's signature shows — the annual winter and spring concerts — each choir performs at numerous civic, church, corporate and private gatherings throughout Chicagoland.

Past appearances have included Carnegie Hall, a performance on the WGN TV Morning Show, singing at Barrington's White House, and a Halloween collaboration with Dancewerks. Other highlights include performing the National Anthem at the United Center for the Chicago Bulls, performing the National Anthem at the Sears Centre for the Windy City Bulls, singing holiday songs at the Holly Ball, and an appearance at Joffrey Ballet's Nutcracker Suite (an annual tradition).

Community outreach — and spreading the joy of music — is a powerful, long-standing tradition at BCC. Our choristers perform at several charitable events each year, such as the Relay for Life, Barrington's Memorial Day Parade and Art in the Barn. Our younger groups also visit many local nursing homes, where they share their repertoire and interact with residents.

THE TOURS

Touring regionally, nationally and internationally is a key component of the BCC experience, as it exposes our children to new choral works and renowned conductors

-- and raises their level of performance and overall professionalism. A major tour is attempted every two to three years, offering many of our choristers once-in-a-lifetime experiences.



BCC has had the good fortune to perform throughout the United States and beyond. In June 2018, BCC Choristers had the distinct privilege to be one of only five choirs from across the United States chosen to perform at the renowned Carnegie Hall. BCC participated in the Children's Choir Series under the direction of Anthony Trecek-King, director of the Boston Children's Chorus. In addition to the Carnegie Hall performance, choristers visited several NYC landmarks and cultural institutions during their four-day visit.

Past tours have taken BCC to several major European cities, including London, Vienna, Budapest, Rome, Florence, Venice and Prague. And in the United States, our choristers have appeared at music festivals in Hawaii, New Orleans and San Francisco.

To quote our founding director, Peggy Crawford: "It is transformational when BCC choristers travel together, share new cultures, meet other singers from countries far removed from America, and offer their hand to these new friends through song. More important than the concluding concert on a foreign stage is the final outcome of that student's understanding of self and worthiness as a performer, on a world mission to connect with others through singing. There really is nothing like it."



TOM VENDAFREDDO, ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Tom Vendafreddo is a Chicago-based educator, music director, and performer. He is the recipient of the Illinois Theatre Association's 2020 Award of Excellence in Professional Theatre.

In 2014, Tom became the Founding Artistic Director of the Chicago Artists Chorale, a nonprofit choral organization comprising professionals from the Chicago arts community. The group is entirely volunteer, performs two concerts annually, and has anywhere from 50-80 singers at any given time.

Tom is a proud graduate of the Eastman School of Music, where he earned dual degrees in Music Education and Vocal Performance, graduating with honors.

Tom then went on to pursue an MFA in Musical Theatre from San Diego State University, where he published a Thesis Project entitled "A Blended Pedagogy: Synthesizing the Best Practices of Opera and Musical Theatre Training Programs to Promote a More Holistic Approach to Training the Singing Actor."

A product of Tom's own multifaceted education is an eclectic career as an educator. He has taught a range of courses including voice, choral music, collaborative piano, musical theatre performance, beginning acting, musicianship, musical theatre history, and theatre marketing and publicity at schools such as Northwestern University, Chicago Conservatory for the Performing Arts (Roosevelt University), San Diego State University, The School at Porchlight (Chicago), Baeksuk University (Seoul, South Korea), Patrick Studios (Melbourne, Australia), North Central College (Naperville, IL), among others.





JOYCE HAQQ GRACE NOTES DIRECTOR

Joyce has more than 20 years of teaching and directing experience with all levels and ages, ranging from Kindermusik through college level. She is currently the Choral Music Director at Carmel Catholic High School in Mundelein. She previously taught in Barrington District 220 and also at Adlai Stevenson High School. Joyce graduated University of Illinois with a Bachelor of Science in Choral Music Education. She also has a Master of Arts in Special Education from Concordia University of Chicago.



RACHEL ELIZABETH MALEY PRINCIPAL PIANIST

Rachel Elizabeth Maley is an artist and teacher based outside of Chicago. A musician since a young age, she performs on multiple instruments and voice, and has worked in various capacities for Lyric Opera of Chicago, the Elgin Youth Symphony Orchestra, Side Street Studio Arts, the Brevard Music Center, and the National Youth Orchestra of Iraq. Rachel attended the University of Chicago intending to study ethnomusicology, but instead developed affinities for dance, comparative literature, and contemporary circus arts. Her creative work embodies this penchant for collaboration across

all media. Rachel is a practitioner of mediation and Cha Dao, the Way of Tea. She is the founder of Still Life Meditation (StillLifeMeditation.net), a center for meditation and self-inquiry in downtown Elgin, IL.



BECKY BRICHTA OPERATIONS MANAGER

Becky joined BCC in June of 2018. She has nearly 20 years of experience leading and directing operations for a variety of musical and theatrical organizations. While working with students is her passion, an even bigger focus is her 3 children that range in age of 10-15 years of age. Becky is thankful for the opportunity to be part of Barrington Children's Choir.



PEGGY CRAWFORD FOUNDER & CONDUCTOR LAUREATE

Peggy is an internationally recognized teacher and conductor of children's voice. Peggy's motivation to start BCC was to enrich children's lives through the love of music and the joy and fulfillment of artistic accomplishment. In June 2010, Peggy made her final routes to the schools in Barrington 220, retiring after 25 years of service in five different schools. In Spring 2017, Peggy raised her baton one last time as artistic director in celebration of 30 years since founding the BCC.

1986...a time in my life that brought me disappointment and unwelcome change. Teaching in the smallest district school, stuck and yearning for more, I was overwhelmed when the school board would grant me permission to form a choir, outside of the school curriculum. They would name the choir - "The Barrington Children's Choir." Of course! A gift had been granted, I would strive to bring children to a place of excellence, rejoicing with song!

We became one, closer year after year. Towns merged, friendships became lifelong, and the BCC was born. Its growth was a nurturing, loving family, which grew newborns to look forward to be old - to sing. In time, the years saw new groups emerge, madrigal singers, men's choir, high school orchestras chimed through our concerts, a miracle in its making. Becoming known in the music circuit, our itineraries soon traveled the states, Carnegie Hall..., and finally our beloved European journeys to the majestic Cathedrals. Inexplainable growth was the outcome of each experience.

Now, that's all the good. Just as you, we were thrown into the Corona Virus nightmare. There were long pauses, attendance dropped, no concerts, no traveling.... Somehow, the 36 years sustained its life span, we would not fail. Our board remained intact. And then, in walked a "used-to-be chorister" soprano, from years ago, a young lad who toured Austria with us in 1998. Our beloved Tom Vendafreddo , now a tenor, would become our new Artistic Director.

I urge all of you to rejoice in our sustained life and legacy. Please support the Barrington Children's Choir in the many ways available. With appreciation and love - *Peggy*






